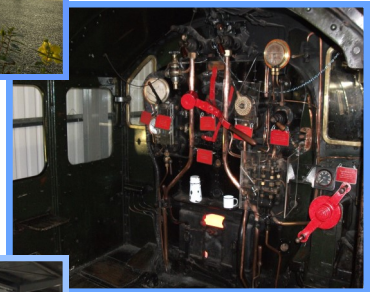
Facilities include

Set alongside the Severn Valley line and adjacent to Highley station, The Engine House, our Visitor and Education Centre, opened its doors for the first time in the spring of 2008.

It is an extremely popular facility which provides educational and enjoyable opportunities for school/college groups of all ages.

The size of a football pitch, The Engine House contains our reserve collection of eight full size steam locomotives, one with visitor access (including a ramp for those in wheelchairs) and a collection of other important railway vehicles. These help tell the story of our railway heritage and why railways are so important as a means of communication and transport.



AVAILABILITY

Visits to The Engine House are available to pre-booked school groups as part of a general visit to the Severn Valley Railway.

ADMISSION CHARGES

Admission to The Engine House for pre-booked school groups is £1-50 per person, children or adults.
