

## PJ Masks Visit – Event Information

- You should arrive at least 30 - 45 minutes before your train departure time. This will allow enough time to reach the station from the station car park, or public 'Pay & Display' car parks in Bridgnorth or Kidderminster.
- Your ticket permits travel on the Railway for the whole day, so you can explore every station and ride on as many trains as you like. Download the train timetable here: [svr.co.uk/PJMasks](http://svr.co.uk/PJMasks)
- When you get off the train at Highley, The Engine House is a short walk from the station. Be sure to follow the signs over the footbridge, or across the barrow crossing when the gates are opened.

Catboy & Luna Girl will be appearing for approximately 25 minutes at intervals throughout the day at The Engine House, Highley, at the following times:

- Catboy: 10.20am, 11.30am, 12.30pm, 1.45pm, 3.00pm
- Luna Girl: 11.00am, 12 noon, 1.00pm, 2.15pm, 3.30pm

Also at The Engine House:

- Magic Shows with A Box of Tricks: 10.45am, 11.45am, 12.45pm, 1.45pm, 2.45pm
- Get up close to our collection 9 full size steam locomotives, including Gordon the big blue engine
- Outdoor Railway themed play area
- Sort the letters in our Mail Train and other interactive exhibits for children and play tables
- Restaurant with children's menu available and gift shop featuring a range of PJ Masks merchandise

Parking Postcodes:

- Kidderminster: Station DY10 1QX, Harriers FC DY10 INB (limited on April 27th), King Charles School DY10 IXA.
- Bridgnorth: Station & NEW West Carpark WV16 5DT.

If possible, we strongly advise you to use public transport, including the excellent mainline train service to Kidderminster Station (large car parks at Rowley Regis and Stourbridge Junction).

**Access for the Less Able –** We are pleased to welcome visitors with accessibility issues. Most of our trains have specially adapted carriages. Ramps, which permit access for wheelchairs to our trains, are available at all stations. If you have a person in your group who has accessibility issues and requires the use of a wheelchair or mobility scooter, please reserve your place on the train at the point of booking.

**Your first train ride –** You MUST travel on the date and train time shown on your email confirmation. Your group will all be seated together by our staff providing you are all together on the platform at the time of boarding. You will NOT be permitted to select the part of the train that you sit in. Once you have travelled on the first train, you may travel on any other service for the rest of the day.

**Buggies & pushchairs –** These will need to be folded on arrival at the station and will be loaded into the brake-van on the train. They can be collected from our staff at the end of each journey. Buggies and pushchairs are identified by numbered tags and a member of your group will be given a corresponding numbered wristband to wear.

**Nappy changing facilities –** Nappy changing facilities are not available on the train. Please use the toilets at Kidderminster, The Engine House or Bridgnorth.

**On-train catering –** A trolley service is usually available on all trains.

**Toilets –** You are strongly advised to use toilets located at our stations.

**Smoking –** Smoking or the use of e-cigarettes is NOT permitted on our trains or anywhere on the Railway. Please look out for advisory signs.
