Available at Kidderminster, Bewdley and Bridgnorth Stations for £4 per day (limited number of disabled spaces available). Overflow parking is available at Kidderminster Harriers FC DY10 1NB, King Charles School DY10 1XA and Bewdley School (Saturday & Sunday only) DY12 1BL – follow the signs.

The Stars of the Show

GWR Large Prairie No. 4144

Based at Tondy from 1957 to 1962, this Large Prairie could be found hauling local passenger trains deep in South Wales. No. 4144 returns to the Severn Valley Railway after a number of years, this time in British Railways livery.

GWR No. 5619

Heavy coal trains were the staple diet for No. 5619 pre-preservation, having been based at Barry from 1950 to 1964. The locomotive made a quick visit to the Severn Valley Railway in 1987 to cover for No. 75069 and other SVR locomotives working away on the mainline.

GWR Pannier Tank No. 6430

No. 6430 worked Autotrains in the South Wales Valleys from 1940 until 1954, being based at Pontypool and Newport during this time. After being withdrawn in 1964 and then saved as a kit of spare parts, restoration work was slow and it returned to steam in 2005.
