**Booking Form**

This year forms are downloadable from the SVR website, please take the time to ensure you have the correct one. **This one is for vehicle owners and one passenger to 'book in' their vehicle for the 2019 event, any extra passengers in period costume may download and fill out a 'prepaid reenactor form' from [www.svr.co.uk/reenactors](http://www.svr.co.uk/reenactors)**

**Travel Permits and Identity Cards**

Vehicle owners will be issued with a travel ticket for the 4 days of the event upon the arrival of you and your vehicle, these must be produced when asked for by any member of SVR staff. Any misuse of these will result in them being revoked and not being re-issued.

If any person booked in does not attend, then his/her ticket is NOT transferable; transferring of travel permits will result in them being removed.

**Clothing**

Although vehicle owners are not specifically required to dress in period clothing (we would love it if you do!), we'd like to make you aware that if you do decide to take part in this respect there are a few simple rules:

Re-enactors should wear appropriate period clothing at all times whilst the event is operating and be mindful to look the part without causing offence; in particular, the wearing of SS and Gestapo uniforms, Adolf Hitler impersonations and the use of swastika armbands.

Whilst in costume, please be aware that you are representing the SVR as a volunteer, so please treat passengers with respect.

## **The Evening Big Band Show**

The vehicle owner plus one passenger are entitled to Big Band Show wristbands at the reduced rate of £6.00 per wristband. These wristbands allow travel on the special untimetabled train that calls at all stations from Bridgnorth; please see your local station staff for the timings of this train. All wristbands should be purchased in advance using the appropriate space on the booking form. Individuals are responsible for their own wristband once it has been issued; wristbands that are lost or left at home cannot be replaced at the discounted cost.

Please also note that Kidderminster carpark will close during the evening for air raid precautions and pyrotechnics, announcements will be made during the evening to advise.

## **Conduct**

The Severn Valley Railway takes its responsibilities very seriously and expects those who take part in their events to do likewise; Re-enactors, traders and vehicle owners must conduct themselves in a safe and responsible manner at all times.

Appropriate personal protective equipment should be used if required. All relevant risk assessments and insurance documents should be presented when requested.

All instructions given by a member of SVR staff, including guards and ticket inspectors should be obeyed immediately and all travel permits should be available for inspection upon request.

Please be mindful about excessive consumption of alcohol on any part of the SVR as this could cause offence to other passengers and become a safety issue for railway staff.

Offensive language or threatening behaviour must not be used to any passenger or member of staff.

Any contact with children should be considered first regarding its nature.

## **Camping**

Camping accommodation on any part of the Severn Valley Railway is available ONLY by prior arrangement with the 1940's committee.

## **Smoking**

Please be aware that all trains and buildings on the Severn Valley Railway and under the concourse at Kidderminster station are all no smoking areas including vaping.

## **Firearms**

No weapon will be used on the Severn Valley railway in a manner likely to cause alarm or distress to any person.

All persons carrying a firearm must be in possession of its deactivation certificate, at all times.

The display and use of live ammunition is not permitted on any part of SVR property.

During the midweek education program, firearm's may not be carried unless the re-enactor is taking part in a pre-arranged, official activity within the SVR.
