You can break your journey at Arley, Highley or Hampton Loade, and wait for the train on its way back from Bridgnorth, or go all the way to Bridgnorth.

#### Riverside walk from Arley to Highley

Leave the train at Arley at **12.50**, and head down the lane for the river. Turn left along the river bank footpath to Highley – a 2.6 mile walk – you may even see some spring lambs! Immediately after the Ship Inn, turn left up the footpath to the station at Highley.

At Highley, your train departs at **2.35pm** back to Kidderminster.

#### Visit The Engine House at Highley

Leave the train at Highley at **1.02pm** to visit The Engine House Visitor Centre, where several of our steam locos are safely on display until it's time for them to be restored for use on our trains once again. The Engine House is a 5-minute walk from Highley station.

Then it's back on the train at **2.35pm** for the journey back to Kidderminster.

#### Visit Bridgnorth

Don't worry if it's raining, there's still plenty to do! Keep warm and dry on the train all the way to Bridgnorth [**arrives at 1.33pm**] where you can visit the gift shop and grab a brew or a pint in the Railwayman's Arms.

Unfortunately not enough time for a walk into the town - Something for another day when you've got more time!

The train heads back to Kidderminster at **2.05pm** – we hope you might even see some sunshine during your last trip!

#### Kidderminster

Once you're back at Kidderminster, you can visit the King & Castle pub, the gift shop and the Railway Museum!
